Eligibility:

Students currently enrolled in University of Toronto Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering are eligible for applying the UT-IMDI industry based summer internship. Interested students need to be:

- In good academic standing
- In their 2nd and 3rd year of undergrad study from MIE, ECE, Engineering Science and Computer Science
- Undergrads can't be in their final semester-i.e. must be eligible to return to their program in the Fall 2020
- Master of Engineering students from MIE, ECE and UTIAS
- Master of Engineering students need to maintain student status by enrolling in a course while working
- Eligible to work in Canada

Application Process:

Students will need to **apply online** (<http://imdi.mie.utoronto.ca/future-students/>) and include a complete application package in order to be considered. These include:

- Completed student application form
- Cover letter and resume (combined into one document)
- Unofficial transcript (can be downloaded from ROSI)
- Copy of Study Permit (International Students Only)

Please note that there will be limited positions available and only applicants selected for interviews will be contacted. Expected date of the internship will be May to August 2020.
